Your host Davies will also showcase Kankakee's **Frank Lloyd Wright's B. Harley Bradley House**. This Prairie Style house designed by Frank Lloyd Wright and built in the late 1900's is acknowledged by the Frank Lloyd Wright Building Conservancy as Wright's first house design that ushered in Wright's Prairie Style. Get your taste buds ready for **Blues Café** a casual diner is known for at least 11 home-made pies available daily. "Good Down home Style Cooking since 1957". This old fashioned restaurant attracts many travelers looking for something unique in Kankakee County.
