DAY TWO

Early bird gets the worm! Head to the Saturday morning Kankakee Farmer's Market that's open May through October and grab some fresh baked goodies, produce or some yummy treats from the food trucks. While you're here, stroll across Schuyler Avenue and visit Roze Boutique, or drum up some nostalgia as you browse Madame Saint Vintage. You'll also want to pop into Just Peachy Co., because you can never have too many clothes...right? Quench your thirst with a delicious iced tea or snuggle up to a cup of coffee at Stefari West Ave. – we recommend to pair your beverage with their delicious avocado toast (add an overmedium egg – you won't regret it)!

After lunch, visit the Merchant Street Art Gallery of Artists with Autism in downtown Kankakee. As one of four galleries in the nation that promote artists diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder, the gallery is a must see. While you're here, check out the French Heritage Museum at the Stone Barn, or the Kankakee Railroad Museum.

Stroll to **Grapes & Hops** to enjoy their "famous" wine-slushies or a flight of local wines and whiskeys. They feature an everchanging variety of Illinois wineries with a hip industrial vibe. We also invite you to check out **Knack Brewing and Fermentations**; their diverse tap list includes lagers and ales and a "comfy like your living room" feel.
